Shared showers and toilet facilities, which are situated at strategic points throughout the accommodation.

Meals:

Full board (breakfast, lunch and dinner are served at the school and a packed lunch is provided on study tours). As well as a variety of global cuisines, students will experience traditional British meals such as roast dinners and fish and chips.

Curfew:

Lights are switched off between 22:30 and 23:00. Students are not allowed outside the school site without supervision.

Supervision:

The school team is available 24 hours a day, seven days a week. House Parents are responsible for student welfare and available for support and advice at any time. The student staff ratio is at least 6:1.

All staff on-site are police checked.
